Re-Opening Plans

The school board has voted to approve the submission of a waiver to allow for TK-2 to return to in-person classes. We are at the early stages of the process and we will keep you all informed of the progress as we hear back from the county agency in charge of approvals. This will likely affect only the students of Mrs. Chavez (K-1). Mrs. Jimenez' class is a combo grades 2-4, and we will wait until more grades are approved for in-person classes. This is a fluid situation and we will know more in the following weeks and months.
